FIBA REFEREE EXAM 2007-08**



1. Y N A field goal attempt by A4 is in the air when the 24-second signal sounds. The field goal is successful. A10 is at the table, waiting to substitute. Shall A10 be permitted to enter the game at this time ?
2. Y N A4 is holding the ball in the back court when A5 and B5 commit a double foul near the end line in Team A's front court. Shall the Team A throw-in take place at the point nearest to where A4 had been holding the ball when the double foul occurred ?
3. Y N The officials erroneously fail to award A4 with two free throws. Team A completes the throw-in and scores a field goal. The error is discovered at this time. Shall the error be corrected?
4. Y N On a final free throw by A4, after the ball has struck the ring, defensive player B4 tips the ball into the basket, while attempting to clear the rebound. The official counts the free throw and credits A4 with one point. Is this correct?
5. Y N Coach B comes onto the floor to attend to injured B5. After 35 seconds, B5 is ready to play. Coach B requests that B5 stay in the game at the expense of a time out. Shall play resume immediately?
6. Y N The officials erroneously fail to award A4 with two free throws. Team A inbounds the ball and B4 intercepts a pass between A5 and A6. B5 dribbles, attempts a try for goal and is unsuccessful. A4 rebounds the ball, throws a long pass to A6 who scores a basket. The error is then discovered. Should the error be corrected and should A4 be awarded two free throws ?
7. Y N Team A scores a field goal with 2:02 remaining in the fourth quarter. With the ball rolling on the floor, should the timer stop the clock at 2:00 remaining ?
8. Y N With 7 seconds expired of the eight seconds to advance the ball from his backcourt, A4, from his backcourt, deliberately bounces the ball off the leg of B4 who is in Team A's front court. The ball bounces back to A4 who recovers the ball in his backcourt. Does A4 have a new eight seconds to advance the ball to the front court ?
9. Y N A5 attempts a 3-point field goal near the end of a period. While the ball is in the air, the signal sounds to end the period. After the signal, B5 causes the backboard to vibrate in such a way as to cause A5's attempt to be unsuccessful. Shall Team A be awarded three points?
10. Y N In attempting a successful lay up, A4 commits a traveling violation. The official disallows the score. Shall the throw-in be administered at the closest point to the infraction ?
11. Y N On a throw-in from out-of-bounds, shall the 24-second shot clock be started as soon as it touches or is touched by any player in the court ?
12. Y N On a final successful free throw, A4 fouls B2. Team A requests a time out. Shall the time out be granted ?
13. Y N A4 is injured. After 25 seconds have passed, Coach A decides to leave A4 in the game at the expense of a time out. Coach A now requests to use the time remaining in the time out to instruct his players. Shall the request be granted ?
14. Y N A4 completes a dribble and releases the ball on a try for goal. The try falls short of the basket. A4 then runs up and recovers the ball and starts a dribble. Is this action legal ?
15. Y N A4 is holding the ball in his/her backcourt and is closely guarded by B4 for 5 seconds. Is this a closely guarded situation resulting in a violation charged against A4 ?
16. Y N Team control ends when the ball has left a player's hand(s) on a pass. Is this correct ?
17. Y N Team A is entitled to a throw-in by virtue of the alternating possession process. Before the throw-in by Team A, a foul is called on Team A. Shall the next alternating possession still favour Team A ?
18. Y N With 1:58 to play in the game, Team A scores and the game clock is stopped. Substitute B10, who has reported to the scorer's table, wishes to substitute. Should B10 be allowed to enter the game ?
19. Y N A4 is awarded two free throws. After the ball is handed to A4 for the final free throw, A5 fills a vacant lane space. The official immediately calls a lane violation on A5 and awards the ball to team B for a throw-in. Is the official correct ?
20. Y N Shall each overtime start with a jump ball ?
21. Y N Team A is in control of the ball when play is interrupted because of an injury to B1. When play resumes, shall the 24 second clock be reset ?
22. Y N Free-thrower A3 commits a violation on a final free throw. A10 is waiting at the table to substitute. Shall A10 be allowed to substitute ?
23. Y N Play is interrupted because of an injury to A1. Team B is granted a timeout. At the end of the timeout, A1 is ready to play. Shall A1 be allowed to remain in the game ?
24. Y N A1 violates on his/her last free throw that is unsuccessful. Shall the ensuing throw-in by Team B occur from behind the end line ?

25. Y N After the official has entered the lane to administer the first of two free throws awarded to A1, but before the ball is placed at the disposal of A1, B10 requests a substitution for B1. Shall the request be granted ?
26. Y N The possession arrow favours Team A. During the half-time interval, A1 is assessed a technical foul. After the free throws by a Team B player, shall the period begin with a throw-in by Team A ?
27. Y N On a try for a goal during the final 2 minutes of play, B3 commits interference. Shall A8 be allowed to substitute at this time ?
28. Y N Airborne shooter A1 releases the ball, lands on one foot, and charges into B1 who is in legal position. This is Team A's fifth foul in the period. Shall B1 be awarded two free throws ?
29. Y N A1 commits an unsportsmanlike foul on B1. B1 misses both free throws. Before the ball is put at the disposal of a Team B player for the throw-in, Coach A requests a time-out. ? Shall the request be granted at this time ?
30. Y N In the final 2 minutes of the game, A1 is called for a traveling violation as he takes off in the lane for a lay-up. Coach A requests and is granted a time-out. After the time out, shall the throw-in take place at the center line opposite the scorer's table ?
31. Y N Players A4 and B4 commit a double foul while Team A is in control of the ball. Shall the shot clock be reset ?
32. Y N Does the 3-second rule in the restricted area only apply when a team is in control in the front court ?
33. Y N Player A1 is assessed his third technical foul during the game. By rule, shall A1 be ejected ?
34. Y N From the front court, a pass from A5 to A3 is deflected into Team A's back court by B1. Shall an 8-second count start as soon as the ball touches the back court ?
35. Y N Team A has control of the ball in its back court. A held ball is called. The possession arrow favours Team A. There is 3 seconds left in the 8-second count. When a Team A player takes control of the inbound pass in his back court, shall the official start a new 8-second count ?
36. Y N Following a try by A4, the ball is bouncing above the rim when A5 commits a foul. The ball then enters the basket. Shall the goal count ?
37. Y N While dribbling in his/her back court, A4 steps on the mid-court line without touching the surface beyond the line. A4 continues to dribble in the back court. Is this legal?
38. Y N A4 releases a try for goal. The 24-second signal sounds after which B4 deflects the ball while it is still in its upward flight. Does the ball become dead immediately?
39. Y N A5 passes the ball from the back court to A4 who is straddling the center line. Shall the official end the 8-second count ?
40. Y N While airborne, A4 catches the ball, lands on one foot, jumps off that foot, lands on both feet, jumps again and releases a try for goal. Is this action legal ?
41. Y N In the last 2 minutes of the 4th quarter, A1 is dribbling in the backcourt when B2 deflects the ball out of bounds. Team A requests a timeout. The official instructs the 24-second operator to reset the shot clock. Is the official correct ?
42. Y N B1 jumps from his/her front court, intercepts a pass thrown by A1, and lands in his/her backcourt. Is this a backcourt violation?
43. Y N No Team B player is occupying the first rebound space during A1's last free throw. A1 misses the free throw. Shall a replacement free throw be awarded to A1 ?
44. Y N With 18 seconds left on the 24-second clock, B1 intentionally kicks a pass intended for A2. The official instructs the operator to leave the shot clock at 18 seconds. Is the official correct?
45. Y N During the interval between the 1st and 2nd quarters, B6 disrespectfully addresses an official. Shall a technical foul be assessed to the Team B coach ?
46. Y N B5 commits a disqualifying foul that does not involve contact with an opponent. Shall any Team A player attempt the resulting free throws ?
47. Y N A5 is awarded 2 free throws. While the ball is dead following the first free throw, A1 is assessed a technical foul. Substitute A10 now requests to enter the game to replace A1. Shall A10 be permitted to enter the game immediately ?
48. Y N A4 has been dribbling the ball for 3 seconds in A's backcourt when a double foul is called in the backcourt. On the ensuing throw-in by A1, A2 catches the ball in Team A's back court. Does Team A have 5 seconds to cause the ball to move into A's frontcourt?
49. Y N A substitution opportunity has ended when A10 runs to the scorer requesting a substitution. The scorer reacts erroneously and the horn sounds. The official blows his whistle and interrupts the game. Shall the substitution be granted ?
50. Y N A1 releases a try for goal. The official blows his whistle for a foul by B4. The ball hits the rim and is rolling on it when B1 bats the ball away. Is this a violation ?
