Dave Buffie Scholarship

- a. The application window for this scholarship will **open on September 1** and **close on September 30**.
- b. Members will submit via email their application to the director of administration.
- c. Applicants will submit a maximum 300-word essay including the following topics:
 - i. The official's current season officiating goals.
 - ii. The official's future officiating goals.
 - iii. Provide an example of how they have been a positive ambassador for the EBOA.
 - iv. Demonstrate / explain their financial need.
- d. All applications will be provided to the family of Dave Buffie. Dave Buffie's family will decide which applicant will be selected to receive the scholarship.
- e. Fund for this application will be disbursed by November 15.

Angie Celino Scholarship

- a. The application period for this scholarship will **begin on February 1** and **end on June 30**.
- b. Members will submit via email to the director of administration the required documentation including:
 - i. Name and contact information of the development opportunity
 - ii. Dates of the opportunity
 - iii. Confirmation of full payment
 - iv. Confirmation of enrolment in either a secondary or postsecondary institution.
- c. Applications meeting the requirements will be approved on a first come first serve basis until the designated funds are exhausted.
