


#### SUMMARY OF CHANGES

- Article 17 Throw-In (MAJOR)
- Article 31.2 Goaltending / Basket Interference (MINOR)
- Article 40 Foul Limits / Game Disqualifications (MINOR)
- Article 44 Correctable Errors (MAJOR)
- Article I.2 Participants' Responsibility (MINOR)
- Appendix A Referee Signals (MINOR)
- Captain's Meeting (NEW)

## ART. 17 – THROW-IN (MAJOR CHANGE)

- Coaches were able to choose to advance the ball to the frontcourt after a time-out in the last 2 minutes.
- NEW Coaches can also decide the spot of the throw-in in the frontcourt on either the table side or opposite side.
  - Only permitted after a successful field goal or free throw.
  - NOT permitted after a foul or violation. The ball would be inbounded on the side closest to where the infraction occurred.



### ART. 31.2 – GOALTENDING / BASKET INTERFERENCE (MINOR CHANGE)

- This is an editorial change to clarify when interference occurs.
- 31.2.3 The goaltending restrictions apply until the ball:
  - NO longer has the possibility to enter the basket.
  - HAS touched the ring.

### ART. 31.2 – GOALTENDING / BASKET INTERFERENCE (MINOR CHANGE)

- 31.2.4 Interference occurs when:
  - A player causes the basket to vibrate or grasp the basket
    (Ring/Net) in such a way that causes the ball to take an unnatural
    bounce or change direction, preventing it from entering the
    basket.

### ART. 40 – FOUL LIMITS AND GAME DISQUALIFICATIONS (MINOR CHANGE)

- New procedures for disqualified players or coaches have been introduced to avoid unnecessary delays.
- For Players:
  - 5 Personal Fouls = Out of the game (May REMAIN on the Bench)
  - 2 T-Fouls / I U-Foul & I T-Foul / 2 U-Fouls = Disqualified Player
- For Coaches:
  - 2 Personal T-Fouls or 3 Bench T-Fouls = Disqualified Coach
- Art 40.6 Any disqualified participant must leave the game immediately (< 30 Seconds) and shall go to and remain in the dressing room for the duration of the game or shall leave the gym.

### ART. 44 – CORRECTABLE ERRORS (MAJOR CHANGE)


• New procedures have been outlined to handle errors that are discovered during the game, with different categories introduced based on the nature of the error (scorekeeping, shot clock, etc.).

### ART. I.2 – PARTICIPANTS' RESPONSIBILITY (MINOR CHANGE)

- New rule emphasizes that all participants—players, coaches, and officials—must demonstrate ethical behavior during games.
- Participants are expected to immediately notify referees about any correctable errors in scorekeeping, fouls, timekeeping, and shot clock operations.

## APPENDIX A – REFEREES' SIGNALS (MINOR CHANGE)

 Introduction of a new 'pass-off' signal to clarify that a player on a drive to the basket is fouled but passes the ball instead of shoots and is not entitled to free throws.



#### CBOC - CAPTAIN'S MEETING (NEW)

- Rationale: The recently completed basketball competition at the Paris 2024 Olympics featured a captain's meeting with the officiating crew.
- The purpose of the meeting was to enhance communication and to develop relationships between the crew and the competitors.
- The pregame meetings were found to be very successful in enhancing communication.
- This season, all High School games (League & Tournaments) will have captain's meetings.

#### CBOC - CAPTAIN'S MEETING (NEW)

- Protocol: During warm-up, at the 7-minute mark, Officials will bring the captains together at the center jump circle.
- The Crew Chief will go through the following points:
  - Crew chief will introduce crew to captains
  - Tell captains to be ready to play at the buzzer as game flow is important.
  - Jerseys to be tucked in before entering the game.
  - After the time outs please return to the floor at horn ready to play.
  - Communicate respectfully with us if you have any questions.
